The following communication, dated 4 July 1997, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Canada.

Follow-up to Hong Kong, China Question 1 in G/ADP/Q1/CAN/1-G/SCM/Q1/CAN/1

Margin of dumping of goods at the exporter level

Question

Would Canada assign specific product groupings an individual normal value such that goods exported at a price above this normal value will not be subject to anti-dumping duties?

Reply

Yes, an individual normal value would be assigned to each specific product grouping when all the information is provided and verified. If the export price is equal to or above the assigned normal value, no anti-dumping duties would be assessed.
