## NOTIFICATION OF LAWS AND REGULATIONS UNDER ARTICLES 18.5 AND 32.6 OF THE AGREEMENTS

### Questions from the EUROPEAN COMMUNITY to THAILAND<sup>1</sup>

The following communication, dated 7 April 1997, has been received from the Permanent Delegation of the European Commission.

Q.1. Why does Article 6.3(2) of the notification, on calculation of normal value based on costs of production, contain none of the comprehensive language on cost allocation as set out in Article 2.2.1.1. of the WTO Agreement?

Q.2 Could Thailand provide details of its rules and procedures on sampling, which may be used in the determination of dumping margins?

Q.3. Will the "lesser duty" examination referred to in Article 12.2(3) of the notification be carried out systematically, or is the use of this provision likely to be limited?

Q.4. Article 15.2 of the notification clearly sets out the one year time-limit for review investigations. Is there a similar stipulation to conform with the WTO Agreement on time limits for the completion of new investigations?
