NOTES TO THE SEMI-ANNUAL REPORT OF ANTI-DUMPING  
ACTIONS SUBMITTED BY CANADA UNDER  
ARTICLE 16.4 OF THE AGREEMENT

1 January 1996 to 30 June 1996

1. The symbol (R) is used if an investigation is opened in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure.

Where an investigation is conducted in the context of a review of an existing anti-dumping measure, the date of completion of the review is shown in column 5, but generally it is not possible to state the margin of dumping in this column. This is because the review procedure was initiated to allow Canadian authorities to determine the current normal value of the imported product, in order to determine, in the future, whether imports of the product are dumped. As the margin of dumping is equal to the difference between the export price and the normal value, it is impossible to determine, *a priori*, the percentage margin of dumping. In addition, Canadian authorities compile statistical data concerning trade volume of the imported product only when reviewing a determination of injury in the context of possible revocation of the anti-dumping measure. As a result, statistical data on trade volume for columns 11, 12 and 13 are not available for investigations of existing anti-dumping measures.

2. Provisional measures apply from the date of a preliminary determination of dumping to the date on which the Canadian International Trade Tribunal makes its finding regarding injury caused to the Canadian industry (maximum 120 days from the notice of the preliminary determination). The percentage represents the estimated weighted average margin of dumping calculated as a percentage of normal value.
3. Either the date of a positive injury finding, in a case of an investigation, or the date of the conclusion of a review of normal values and export prices in cases where there is an existing Canadian International Trade Tribunal finding of injury. The percentage represents the weighted average margin of dumping calculated as a percentage of normal value at the time of the final determination of dumping.
4. The word "Renewal" indicates that an existing undertaking was renewed following a review of the injury question; the word "Amendment" indicates that a technical amendment was made to the undertaking, normally to account for changes in the price or terms contained therein. The words "Not Renewed" indicate that an existing undertaking was not renewed following a review of the injury question and, as a result, was allowed to expire on its anniversary date.
5. The trade volume is based on statistical data for the latest available 12-month period prior to initiation, except as follows:  
  
\* 01.01.94 to 31.12.94 (Dry Pasta originating in or exported from Italy)
6. A review of the undertaking for frozen prepared pot pies and frozen prepared dinners originating in or exported from the United States, initiated on 19.10.95, was concluded on 14.01.96. As a result of this review, it was concluded that the undertaking accepted on 15.07.85 no longer served the purpose for which it was intended; and as such, was allowed to expire on 14.01.96, thereby terminating all proceedings in the case.

7. For purposes of the re-investigation initiated on 27.11.95 in respect of potatoes originating in or exported from the United States, the review concluded on 13.05.96 and the new normal values came into effect on 01.08.96.
8. For purposes of the re-investigation initiated on 27.11.95 in respect of yellow onions originating in or exported from the United States, the review concluded on 13.05.96 and the new normal values came into effect on 01.08.96.
9. For purposes of the re-investigation initiated on 23.03.96 in respect of refined sugar originating in or exported from the United States, the review involved those exporters shipping specialty sugar products only.
10. With respect to the investigation of bacteriological culture media, the definition of the goods named one exporter in the United Kingdom.
11. With respect to the investigation on bacteriological culture media, the definition of the goods named two exporters in the United States.
