INFORMATION TO BE NOTIFIED TO THE COMMITTEE WHERE A SAFEGUARD INVESTIGATION IS TERMINATED WITH NO SAFEGUARD MEASURE IMPOSED

EL SALVADOR

The following communication, dated 12 February 2001, has been received from the Permanent Mission of El Salvador.

El Salvador hereby notifies that following a request by the interested parties, its authority has issued a Final Resolution dated 5 February 2001 ordering the suspension of the administrative investigation procedure to impose a safeguard measure in respect of imports of pig-meat and by-products thereof included under SAC headings: 0203.11.00 – Carcasses and half carcasses; 0203.12.00 – Hams, shoulders and cuts thereof, with bone in; 0203.19.00 – Other; 0203.21.00 – Carcasses and half carcasses; 0203.22.00 – Hams, shoulders and cuts thereof, with bone in; 0203.29.00 – Other; 0206.30.10 – Skin; 0206.30.90 – Other; 0206.41.00 – Livers; 0206.49.10 – Skin; 0206.49.90 – Other; 0209.00.10 – Pig fat free of lean meat; 0209.00.20 – Other pig fat; 0210.11.00 – Hams, shoulders and cuts thereof, with bone in; 0210.12.00 – Bellies (streaky) and cuts thereof; 0210.19.00 – Other. Accordingly, the action is considered to have been withdrawn.

The said Resolution was duly published in Official Journal No. 30, Volume 350, of 9 February 2001, and in the newspaper *El Mundo* of the same date.
