5.	Title, language and number of pages of the notified document: Interim Marketing Authorization regarding the use of Tragacanth Gum in Anchovy Sauce (English and French, page 678)
6.	<p>Description of content: Provision currently exists in the <i>Food and Drug Regulations</i> for the use of tragacanth gum as a stabilizing agent in a variety of foods. Health Canada has received a submission to permit the use of tragacanth gum as a stabilizing agent in anchovy sauce at a maximum level of use of 0.75 per cent. Evaluation of available data supports the effectiveness and safety of this new use for tragacanth gum.</p> <p>Therefore, it is the intention of Health Canada to recommend that the <i>Food and Drug Regulations</i> be amended to permit the optional use of tragacanth gum as a stabilizing agent in the manufacture of anchovy sauce at a maximum level of use of 0.75 per cent.</p> <p>As a means to improve the responsiveness of the regulatory system, an Interim Marketing Authorization (IMA) is being issued to permit the immediate use of tragacanth gum as indicated above, while the regulatory process is undertaken to formally amend the Regulations. A revision to this notification will be published at the start of the amendment process and Members will be given the opportunity at that time to submit comments on this proposed measure.</p>
