Addendum

The following communication, dated 16 April 2004, is being circulated at the request of the delegation of Colombia.

Health-Related Measures to Prevent the Introduction into Colombia of Avian Influenza: Processed Meat Products of Avian Origin

The health measure notified in document G/SPS/N/COL/80 of 19 March 2004 has been amended pursuant to Colombian Agricultural Institute (ICA) Resolution No. 578 of 1 April 2004 to the effect that the entry into Colombia of processed meat products of avian origin from the United States of America which have been subjected during manufacturing or processing to a minimum temperature of 70 degrees centigrade for at least ten minutes or 80 degrees centigrade for at least three minutes will be permitted.
