Description of content: The current epidemiological situation of Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) makes it necessary to update Departmental Resolution No. 109-98-AG-SENASA, by extending its scope to cover Denmark and maintaining the application of the above restriction until risk assessments are carried out and duly checked and endorsed by SENASA and the International Office of Epizootics (IOE).
