| 5. | Description of content: This standard establishes specifications concerning general characteristics, additives and ingredients, chemical composition, microbiological characteristics, product hygiene, packaging and mandatory labelling information. It applies to the product defined as follows: tomato concentrate prepared by concentrating juice from healthy, ripe, red tomatoes (<i>lycopersicum-esculentum P-Mill</i>). Three terms can be used to describe tomato concentrate, depending on the percentage of natural, soluble, dry tomato matter. They are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• tomato single concentrate – minimum content 20%;• tomato double concentrate – minimum content 28%;• tomato triple concentrate – minimum content 36%. |
