The following communication by the United States is being circulated.

Acetamiprid; Pesticide Tolerance

This Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulation (final rule) establishes tolerances for residues of acetamiprid N1-[(6-chloro-3-pyridyl)methyl]-N2-cyano-N1-methylacetamidine in or on citrus dried pulp, citrus fruit group, cotton gin byproducts, cotton undelinted seed, grape, fruiting vegetable group, leafy brassica vegetable group, leafy vegetable (except brassica) group, pome fruit group, and tomato paste; and tolerances for the combined residues of acetamiprid and IM-2-1 N1-[(6-chloro-3-pyridyl) methyl]-N2-cyano-acetamidine in or on fat, meat, and meat byproducts of cattle, hog, horse, goat, and sheep; milk; poultry eggs, fat, liver, and meat. The petitioner requested these tolerances under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act of 1996.

This regulation is effective 27 March 2002. Objections and requests for hearings must be received on or before 28 May 2002.
