Addendum

The following communication, dated 12 June 2002, has been received from the United States.

Triflumizole; Pesticide Tolerance

This regulation (final rule) establishes tolerances for the combined residues of triflumizole, 1-(1-((4-chloro-2-(trifluoromethyl) phenyl)imino) -2-propoxyethyl)-1H-imidazole) and its metabolites containing the 4-chloro-2-trifluoromethylaniline moiety, calculated as the parent compound in or on cucurbit vegetables, strawberries, sweet cherries, and tart cherries. The petitioner requested these tolerances under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act of 1996. In addition, this regulatory action is part of the tolerance reassessment requirements of section 408(q) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (FFDCA) 21 U.S.C. 346a(q), as amended by the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA) of 1996. By law, EPA is required to reassess 66% of the tolerances in existence on 2 August 1996, by August 2002, or about 6,400 tolerances. This regulatory action will count for 26 reassessments toward the August 2002 deadline.

This regulation (final rule) is effective 12 June 2002. Objections and requests for hearings must be received on or before 12 August 2002. The full text of this addendum (final rule), including instructions for submitting objections and requests for hearings, is available from the address below.

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
