This Notice is, with regard to the regulations contained therein, identical to the Notice to the Shipping Industry amending Notice to the Shipping Industry No. 68/1992. An indicative summary of the technical regulations appears below: Articles 2, 3 and 4. This Notice shall implement IMO Resolution A.694(17). Additionally, the rules are also based on ISO Standard 8728 accepted by the International Standards Organization which is based on IMO Resolution A.424(XI) and does not deviate therefrom. This Notice contains rules governing gyrocompasses for the purposes of navigation on board ocean-going ships. This Notice is, with regard to the regulations contained therein, identical to the Notice to the Shipping Industry amending Notice to the Shipping Industry No. 68/1992. 7.	<p>Objective and rationale: If the draft amendment of the Notice contains quantitative import restrictions or measures of equal effect within the meaning of the Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade then such measures are justified in the interests of protecting public health and safety. With regard to foreign products which conform to the requirements, established in the country of origin, Article 7 contains a provision relating to mutual recognition.</p>
