NOTIFICATION OF EMERGENCY MEASURES

Addendum

The following communication, dated 14 February 2003, has been received from Mexico.

Extension of Mexican Official Emergency Standard NOM-EM-004-SEDG-2002, Design and Construction of Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) Installations

Given the need to protect human safety and in view of the continued validity of the reasons for the issue of Mexican Official Emergency Standard NOM-EM-004-SEDG-2002, "Design and Construction of Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) Installations", published in the Diario Oficial de la Federación (Official Journal) of 18 June 2002 and circulated to the Members of the Committee on Technical Barriers to Trade under notification number G/TBT/N/MEX/27 on 6 August 2002, the Government of Mexico, through the Ministry of Energy, considers it necessary, pursuant to Article 48 of the Federal Law on Metrology and Standardization, to extend the period of validity of this Official Emergency Standard for a further six months from 19 February 2003.
