5.	Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document: Swedish National Road Administration's regulation on motorcycles (82 pages, in Swedish)
6.	Description of content: The draft regulation specifies requirements on the design and equipment of motorcycles. The new regulation replaces the existing regulation VVFS 1999:39. The basic rules regarding design and equipment of vehicles in the former Vehicle Decree (1972:595) and the sections regarding design and equipment of vehicles in the Military Road Traffic Decree (1974:97) and the Ordinance concerning vehicles in international road traffic in Sweden (1987:27) have been incorporated in the regulations. Previous national requirements are replaced by the corresponding technical provisions in EC-directives. The requirements now also apply to equipment voluntarily mounted to a vehicle. The regulation contains provisions regarding new as well as old vehicles which have been brought into use with regard to the transitional provisions given in the Vehicle Decree. The regulation has been given a linguistic and legal update.
7.	Objective and rationale, including the nature of urgent problems where applicable: The aim is to better adapt the regulation to existing EC-directives concerning construction of vehicles and to give it a linguistic and legal update. The new regulation has been prepared as a result of a new Vehicle Act (2002:574) and a new Vehicle Ordinance (under notification according to directive 98/34/EC) which are being introduced in Sweden.
