### Communication from Ukraine

#### Revision

The Ministry for Foreign Economic Relations and Trade of Ukraine has submitted the following changes to the draft schedule of specific commitments in the services sector (Page 7, Section 2 Communication Services, Telecommunication Services).

<p><i>3. Telecommunication Services</i></p> <p>In discharge of commitments set forth by this proposal, the following general conditions should be observed:</p> <p>I. The right to render any telecommunication service is given by a license, which is issued on the principles of transparency, objectivity and non-discrimination.</p> <p>II. The license confirming the right to render any telecommunication service is issued in compliance with the law of Ukraine in force, to those enterprises, where the share of foreign investment in the statutory fund does not exceed 49 per cent.</p> <p>III. Equipment connected to common use networks, or having access to these networks, must be certified in compliance with the law of Ukraine in force.</p> <p>IV. The license confirming the right to render any telecommunication service, which requires frequency resources, is issued upon availability of free frequency bands, as well as electromagnetic compatibility of equipment used.</p>
