(Countries are ranked in descending order (from left to right) of the sum of merchandise exports and imports in 2001)

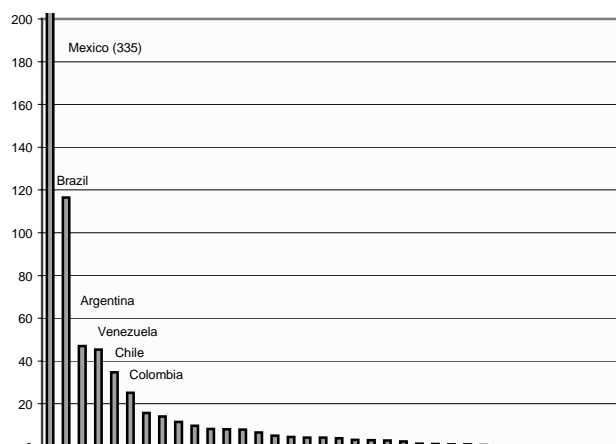
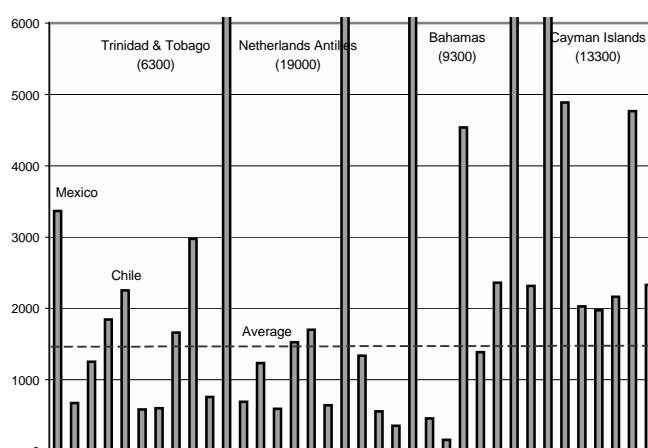
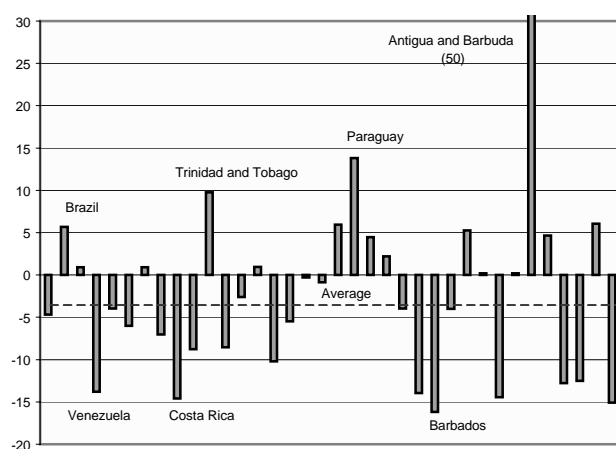
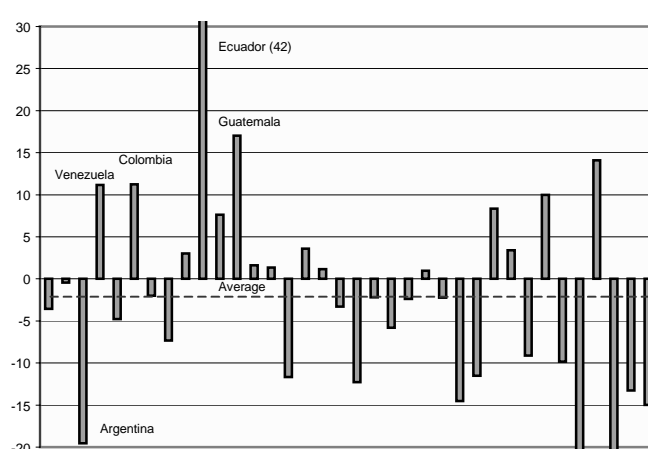
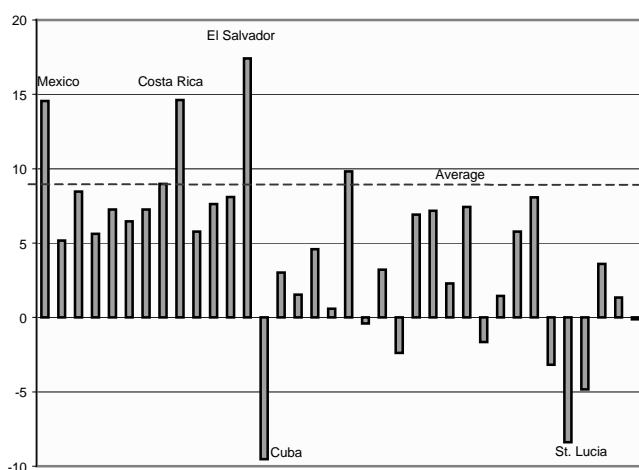
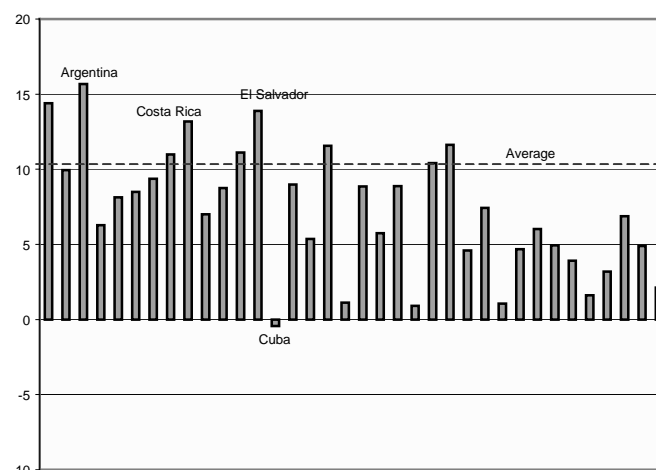

(Countries are ranked in descending order (from left to right) of the sum of merchandise exports and imports in 2001)

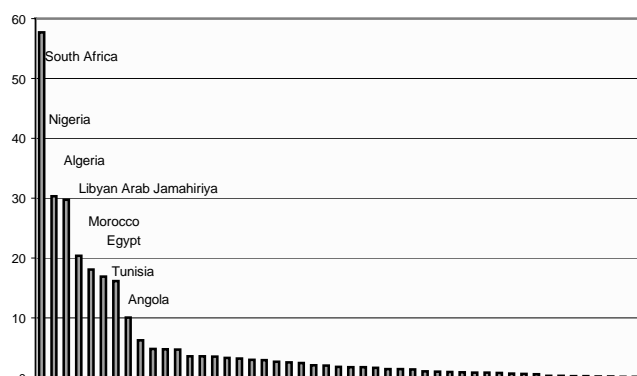
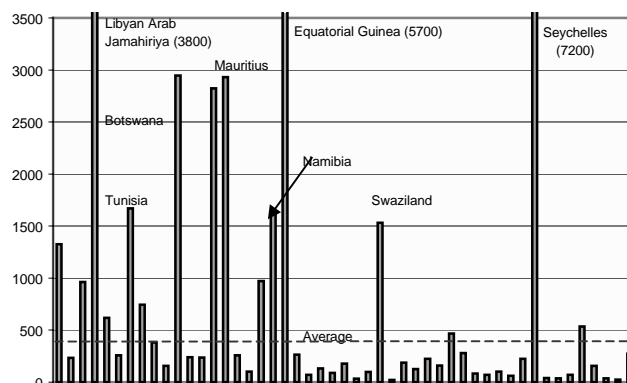
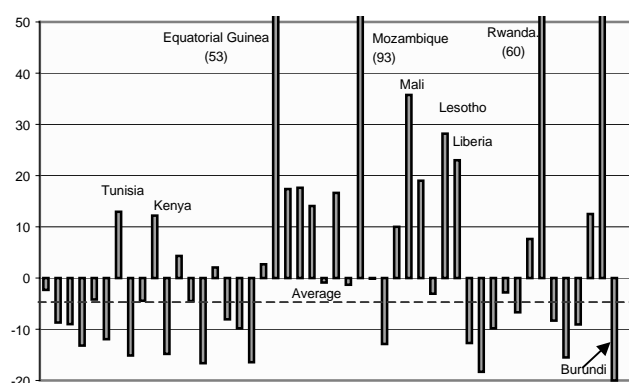
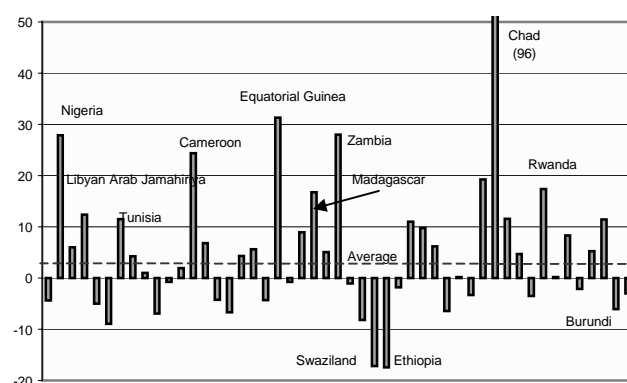
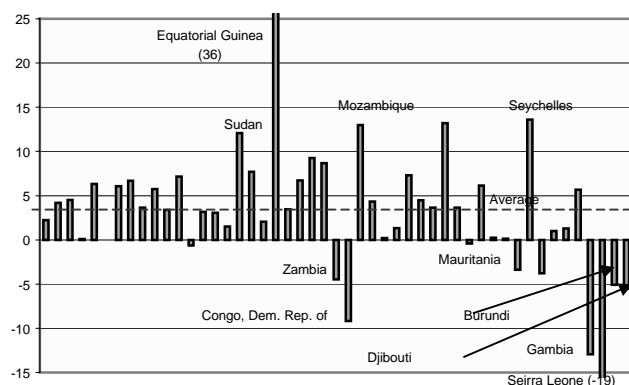
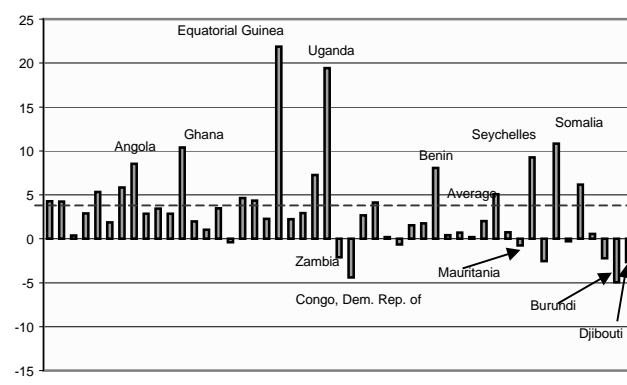

(Countries are ranked in descending order (from left to right) of the sum of merchandise exports in 2001)

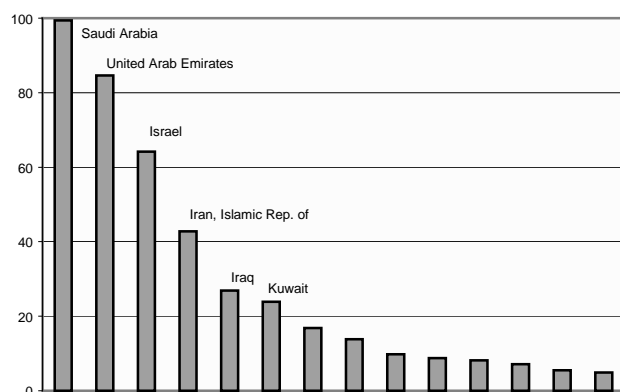
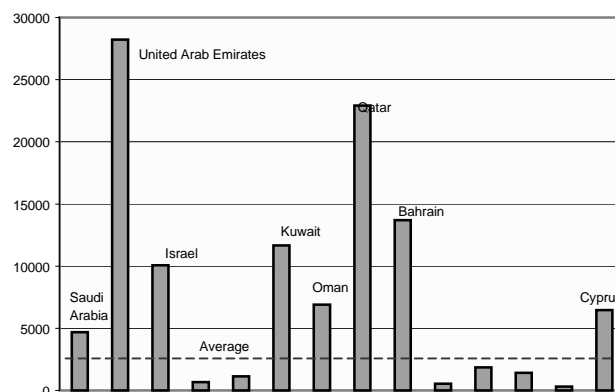
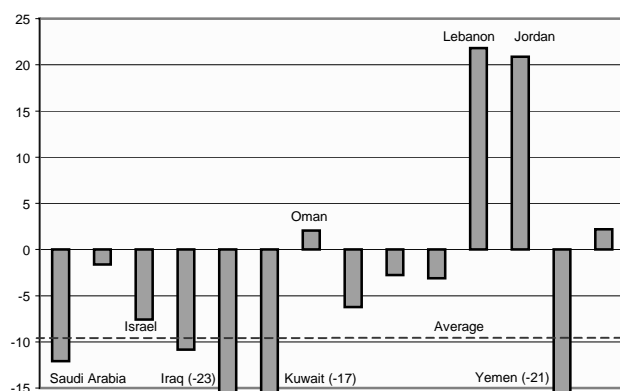
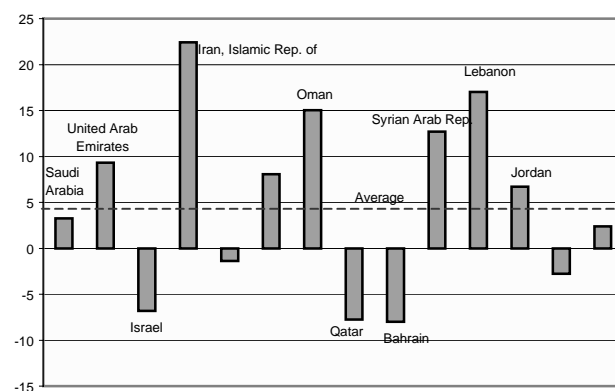
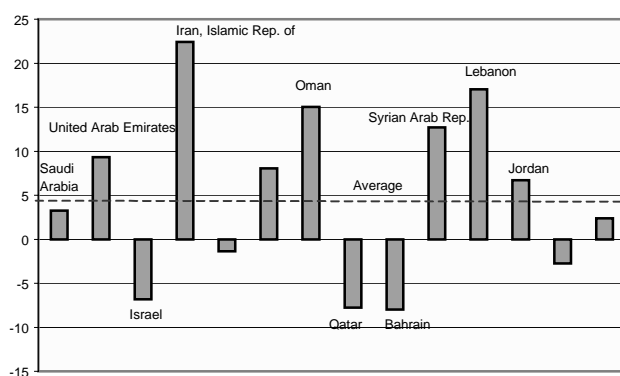
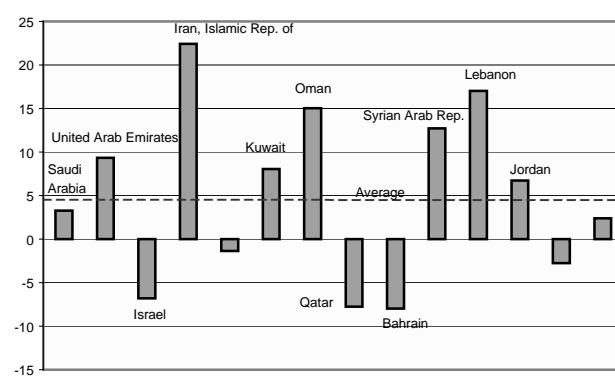

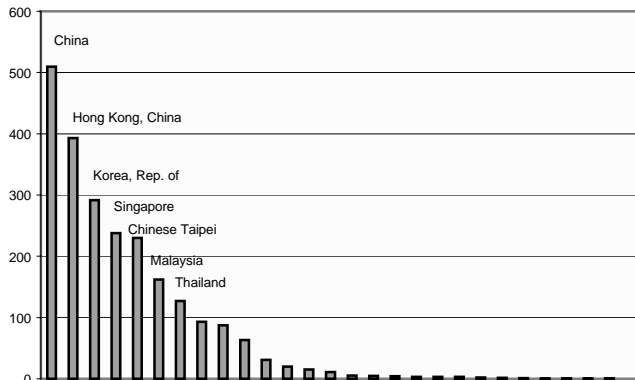

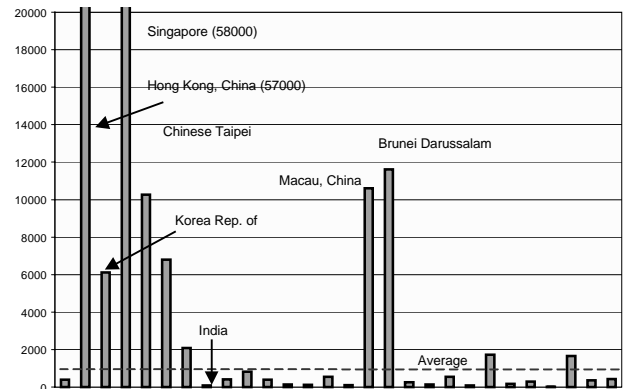
Developing Asia. Merchandise trade by economy, 1990-2001

(Countries are ranked in descending orders (from left to right) of the sum of merchandise exports and imports in 2001)

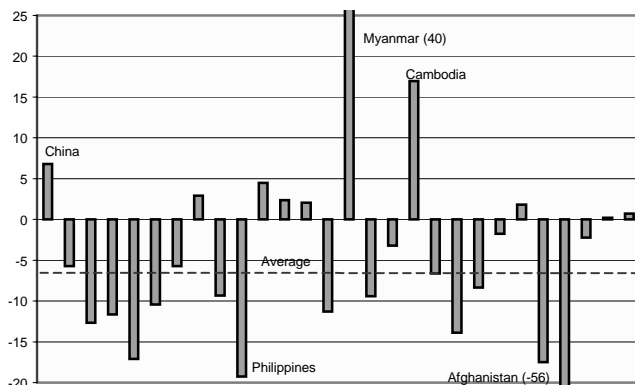
Merchandise trade of devg. Asian countries, 2001
(Exports plus imports, billion dollars)



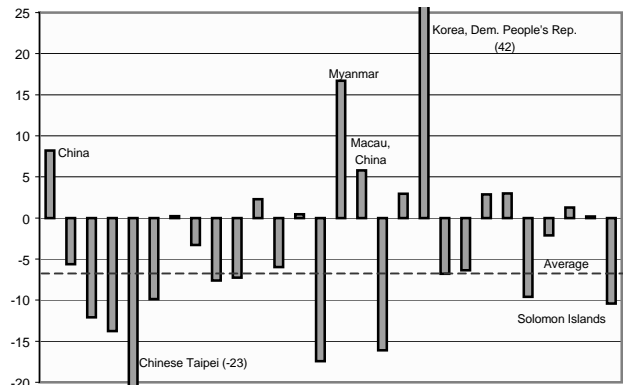
Per capita merchandise trade of devg. Asian countries, 2001
(Exports plus imports, dollars)



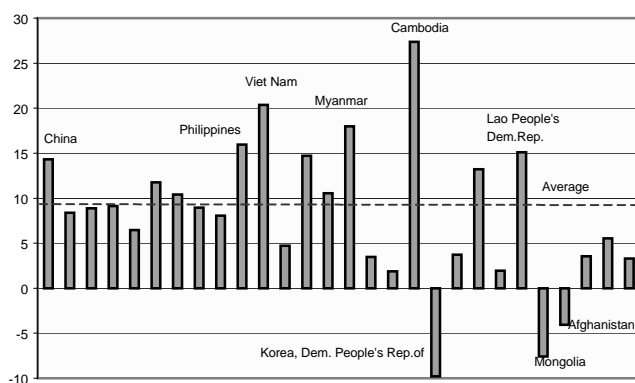
Merchandise exports of devg. Asian countries, 2001
(Percentage change in dollar values)



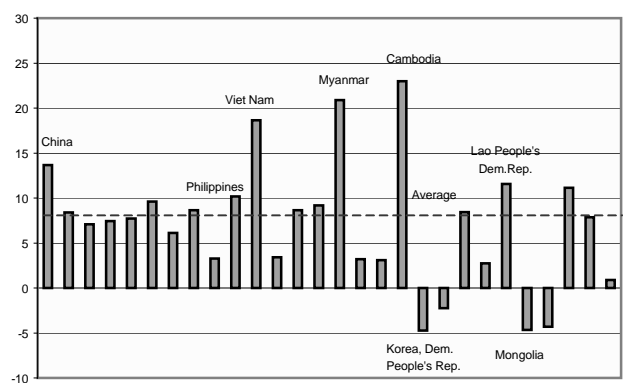
Merchandise imports of devg. Asian countries, 2001
