NOTIFICATION

On 17 June 1996, the following notification concerning the administration of tariff quotas (Table MA:1) for the calendar year 1996 was received from the delegation of **Switzerland**.

SWITZERLAND

The Table MA:1 is submitted in its entirety for reasons of transparency and readability; the material changes as compared with Swiss Notification G/AG/N/CHE/1 for the second half of 1995 are highlighted in bold type (see tariff quotas Nos. 05 and 06 together with Nos. 23 and 25, items (b)(iii), allocation to importers). The differences in tariff numbering result from the fact that Notification G/AG/N/CHE/1 comprised headings from Switzerland-Liechtenstein Schedule LIX, whereas the present notification is based on the tariff numbers in the Switzerland-Liechtenstein Consolidated Loose-Leaf Schedule (LFM) notified on 22 November 1995, which includes the transposition to HS 1996.

A. General remarks concerning the third column	
(b) Allocation to importers:	in the absence of remarks concerning subparagraphs (ii), (iii) and (iv), the following provisions apply:
(ii)	A general import licence (PGI) is required for imports under a tariff quota (TQ). This licence is granted automatically and is for statistical purposes. Persons liable to customs controls must show the number of their licence on the customs declaration. The licence is not transferable and is generally not limited in time. Shares of TQ are only granted to individuals, businesses and organizations (irrespective of nationality) that: (a) are established on Swiss customs territory; (b) import goods in the sector concerned for business purposes; and (c) provide guarantees that, where necessary, they can meet the requirements and undertake the commitments related to utilization of shares of TQ. Producers of agricultural products and their marketing entities are not usually entitled to tariff quotas if they are protected by commitments undertaken for the allocation of TQ.
(iii)	If import at the TQ rate is authorized provided that the importer purchases a fixed proportion of domestic products, an importer meeting this requirement may import at the TQ rate even if the TQ has been exhausted.
(iv)	Shares of TQ may not be transferred. They are usually granted for a limited period.
