In G/LIC/N/3/GHA/2, dated 21 August 2001, Ghana states that it does not maintain an import licensing system since it abolished its import licensing system in 1989.

Does Ghana regulate the import of products with health and security implications such as explosives, armaments and narcotics? If it does and if not through a system of import licensing, how are such products regulated? How would importers learn about the regulations and requirements applicable to such imports?
