

REPLIES TO QUESTIONNAIRE ON IMPORT LICENSING PROCEDURES

Notification under Article 7.3 of the Agreement on Import Licensing Procedures

BURKINA FASO

Addendum

The following communication, dated 24 November 2000, has been received from the delegation of Burkina Faso.

1. The information provided in the first notification (G/LIC/N/3/BFA/1) remains the same as regards:

Systems;

Products subject to the Special Import Authorization (ASI);

Products subject to the Special Export Authorization (ASE);

Products subject to the Prior Import Declaration (DPI);

Procedures;

Eligibility to import or export.

2. Changes were made to the list of products subject to the National Conformity Certificate (G/LIC/N/3/BFA/1, paragraph 2(v)). The new list, which entered into force on 17 May 2000, concerns the following products:

Cold curing/vulcanising glue; canned food of animal, halieutic, or plant origin; wheat flower; insecticides, aerosol and coil; pesticides; milk; batteries; tyres and inner tubes for bicycles, mopeds and motorcycles; rice; granulated powdered or cube sugar; cigarettes and tobacco; polyethylene and polypropylene bags; tomato concentrates; liqueurs; wine; beer; sparkling beverages; metal plates; sodium hypochloride (bleach); vinegar; salt; carbide; mayonnaise, mustard, butter, margarine; tea and coffee; biscuits; cubes and flavours for seasoning; pharmaceutical alcohol; baker's yeast and raising agents; cosmetics and perfumery; pasta; concrete reinforcing rods; gas cylinders.
