According to the procedures of the SCM Committee, the last review of 1998 new and full subsidy notifications will occur in conjunction with the Autumn 1999 regular meeting to be held during the week of 1 November 1999. At that meeting the Committee will review all subsidy notifications which have been circulated in all three working languages not less than 19 weeks before the meeting, i.e. by 21 June 1999.

6. Members who have not yet submitted their notifications are urged to do so with the utmost dispatch so that they may be translated and circulated by 21 June 1999.
