Addendum

The following communication, dated 22 May 2003, has been received from Canada.

Regulations Amending the Food and Drug Regulations (1326 - Methoxyfenozide)

This regulatory amendment will establish Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) under the *Food and Drugs Act* for residues of methoxyfenozide in apples, crabapples, loquats, mayhaws, oriental pears, pears and quinces, and in fat, meat and meat by-products of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep, and for residues of methoxyfenozide and its metabolite in kidney and liver of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep, in order to permit the import and sale of food containing these residues. By virtue of subsection B.15.002(1) of the *Food and Drug Regulations*, the MRL for other foods is 0.1 parts per million (ppm).

After the review of all available data, the PMRA has determined that MRLs for methoxyfenozide of 1.5 ppm in apples, crabapples, loquats, mayhaws, pears, oriental pears and quinces, and 0.1 ppm in fat, meat and meat by-products of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep, and an MRL for methoxyfenozide, including its metabolite, of 0.1 ppm in kidney and liver of cattle, goats, hogs, horses and sheep would not pose an unacceptable health risk to the public.
