4.	Title and number of pages of the notified document: Removal of the Import Ban on Live Ruminants and Products and By-Products of Ruminant Origin from Uruguay. Departmental Resolution No. 089-2002-AG-SENASA.
5.	Description of content: Removes the import ban on live ruminants and products and by-products of ruminant origin from Uruguay. The ban will remain in place for the other countries mentioned in Departmental Resolution No. 108-2001-AG-SENASA, for as long as their sanitary status with regard to foot-and-mouth disease continues to show no improvement. Authorizes imports of products and by-products of ruminant and swine origin, provided they fulfil the animal health requirements established by SENASA, in order to prevent the introduction and spread of foot-and-mouth disease in Peru.
