Dear Ambassador Szepesi,

Further to my letters of 28 December 2000 and 12 January 2001 regarding Canada's third stage of integration under the Agreement on Textiles and Clothing (ATC), this is to inform the TMB of two corrections.

First, with regard to my letter of 28 December 2000, the total volume of imports integrated under the third stage of integration reported at the end of the table attached to that letter should read 617,003,585 SMEs. The percentage of integration under the third stage remains at 18.03 per cent.

Second, with regard to my letter of 12 January 2001, the first sentence of the fourth paragraph of that letter should read (corrections shown in bold):

"As a consequence of correcting this computation problem, the total volume of imports of ATC products in 1990 is, as indicated above, 3,421,389,685 SMEs, and not **3,420,664,019** SMEs as reported in Canada's letter of **20** May 1997 to the TMB and circulated in WTO document G/TMB/N/214/Corr.1."
