CANCELLATION OF THE COMMEMORATION OF THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY
OF THE HAVANA CONFERENCE ON TRADE AND EMPLOYMENT

General Information

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Cuba wishes to inform Members that, owing to unforeseen circumstances, the Cuban Government has been obliged to cancel the various activities that had been scheduled for 19 to 21 of this month on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the holding in Cuba of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Employment, which concluded with the adoption of the Havana Charter, as mentioned in Cuba's previous communication, WT/L/227 of 16 September 1997.

It wishes to convey its sincere thanks to the Missions accredited to the WTO for the interest shown in this commemoration, while greatly regretting any inconvenience that this cancellation may have caused them, for which it presents its apologies together with the assurances of its highest consideration.
