Article XXVIII:3 - Notification by Canada

Addendum

The following communication, dated 23 January 1998, has been received from the Permanent Mission of Canada.

This is in reference to Canada's communication circulated to Members under the document G/SECRET/1 of March, 1 1995 containing a notice of modification of tariff bindings on certain products of interest to the European Communities.

Canada wishes to inform Members that following the conclusion of its GATT Article XXIV:6 negotiations with the European Communities subsequent to the enlargement of the European Communities to Austria, Finland and Sweden, Canada withdraws the proposed modifications of the tariff bindings on the products cited in the above communication and confirms that the levels of the tariff bindings on such products remain as prescribed in Canada's Uruguay Round Schedule of Concessions (Schedule V) and set out below.
